

SENIOR CARE OPTIONS

Adult Day Care

These organizations have structured care for the elderly and disabled of all ages. Adult daycare centers generally provide activities (recreational and therapeutic), meals, personal care (bathing, grooming), nursing services (medication administration, lab testing, wound care), and therapy (physical, occupational, speech). Care is arranged for specific days and times and may include programs for persons with memory loss problems such as Alzheimer's. Transportation may be available. Some services are covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance.

Assisted Living

Assisted living communities offer private living units (with bathroom and provisions for emergency response) for adults needing some assistance, but not requiring 24-hour nursing care. Residents may receive assistance with activities of daily living (bathing, dressing, grooming, eating, toileting, and transferring), and assistance with self-administration of medications. Meals, housekeeping, transportation, laundry, and clerical services are also available. Residents may arrange directly with a Home Health Care Agency or private individual to receive health care services.

Services include skilled nursing, therapy (physical, occupational, respiratory, speech, infusion) and personal care (bathing, oral care). Some services are covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance. Home Health Care agencies are licensed by the state and must meet specific standards of patient care.

Hospice

Hospice programs provide end-of-life care to terminally ill patients and their families. Hospice utilizes a team approach to meet the medical, psychological and spiritual needs of the patient and family. Nursing, personal hygiene, social workers, and pastoral care are available. Many programs also offer grief counseling and support groups. Hospices are licensed by the state. Core hospice services are reimbursed by Medicare, Medicaid and most private insurance plans. Other services are at no cost to the patient or family.

Long Term Care Facilities

Long term care facilities provide 24-hour care. Skilled care (skilled nursing or therapy) may be required under specific circumstances. Intermediate care is a less intensive level of care than skilled care. Most long term care facilities offer both levels of care. Many also offer a personal care level for those who do not have a skilled need. Some may specialize in only one level (usually personal care). Most long term care facilities accept private pay, Medicare and Medicaid. Long term care facilities are licensed by the state and must meet specific standards of patient care.

Varying levels of Alzheimer's/Dementia care are available in many long term care facilities. Some facilities offer separate, secured units and some do not. Also, staff may or may not have special training.

Long term care insurance, depending on the policy, can help pay for nursing home, assisted living, and/or home care (home health, personal care, and companion services). Policies vary widely in services covered, choice of care providers, and cost.

These organizations provide general or specific services for those living at home. The assistance may include, but is not limited to: self-care assistance (also known as personal care, or assistance with eating, dressing, toileting, bathing, mobility and/or transfers), and/or household assistance (also known as homemaker, or assistance with housekeeping, laundry, meal planning & preparation, shopping and/or bill paying). These organizations may also provide companion/sitter services, escort, medication reminders, transportation and/or other services.

Respite Care

Respite allows a caregiver to have "time off" to continue supporting those who need their help. One form of such care is having the individual who needs help attend an adult day care center (see the Adult Day Care section). Another option is respite care provided in one's home by private pay in-home sitters and companions (see the Personal Services and General Assistance section).

Some assisted living communities and long term care facilities offer overnight respite (relief) for caregivers. This can vary from one night to several nights depending on the facility and the room availability (see the Assisted Living and Long Term Care Facility sections).

Reverse Mortgages

A reverse mortgage is a loan that allows a senior to borrow off the value of their home. The extra money that you receive from this loan can allow you to spend your retirement years in the home you've worked so hard to have. The loan is usually paid back to the lender by the sale of the home either when you (the senior) decide to move permanently, or at death.

Reverse mortgages can be complicated, and the pros and cons should be given great consideration. Counseling by a professional is highly recommended and sometimes even required.
